

# **HPI – SAVAGE FLUX**

Now here is something interesting; a Savage Flux (no dinky – toy this) Out of interest's sake for you boffins out there, this baby does 180km. I'm not kidding.

And here it sits with a broken shock absorber that costs a whopping R600.00. As if I do not have enough grey hairs – now I would have to fork out that much moola? For a shock? I don't think so!





Now I'm not one for this type of sport but do like a challenge. Problem being the dirt and oil etc. and of course just what type of plastic the shock is made from.



I dumped everything into a bottle of acetone and cleaned the lot up. Did a plastic test and sighed in relief. The next step was to 'V' the outer edges 45° with a sharp blade. That done, I positioned the two parts together, added two drops of satlon 105 and gave pressure for one minute. The next step was to add the bi-carbonate of soda into the 'V' and over the edges. Smooth said bi-carb and add a few drops of satlon. See pics.



Total amount of satlon 105 used for repair: 5 drops. Total time for repair: 5 minutes.
