Now here is something one does not see every day. (The requests I get sometimes astounds even me)

For all you guys and gals out there, we are bringing in one or two new products to add to our fantastic list of only one product, namely: Satlon 105 (our flagship). LOL.

Satlon 601 is seeing the light of day very soon inclusive of Satlon Putty. (Think of Pratley Putty with a twist).

Now sometimes it behooves one to think out of the box so I sat there scratching my head while I took a long worried look at this Puppy.



After doing a plastic test and cleaning the broken base, I discovered that Satlon 105 was just perfect for the job. My problem was that I was afraid that alone, the glue may just not be enough. (It's a super glue ppl, not a magic glue).



So what to do? Cleaned up everything. 'V' the edges. Roughened the plastic with very rough sand paper and stuck the pieces together with satlon 105. Then poured liberal amounts of Bi-carb and added more satlon 105. Still. The worries... and then (light bulb) I had an idea.

As we are still doing experimentation on Satlon Express Putty, this may just be the ideal situation for it.



I love it when a plan comes together.

Now here's the secret to Satlon Express Putty; to avoid offcuts, slice a minimum amount off. (one can always add to it afterwards if it is discovered that more is required). Knead for 20 – 30 seconds. You have between 5 and 10 minutes to get your shaping/molding done and then it gets warm and starts to set. Setting takes 12 hours but after 2 – 3 hours a paring knife or other shaping tool can be used. Just be careful otherwise you will have to start from scratch again. Remember that you can use water to smooth the surface down.
